
A query was sent to BAC dated June 19,2023 regarding some considerations on the technical specifications for the procurement of One (1) unit Military Camera System with Accessories. Response is as follows:

	CLARIFICATIONS FROM MJZ INC.	RESPONSE
1.	<p>Bid Document Item 5.3, Item c.i page 12 and 13 - please confirm if this is applicable in this bid</p> <p>a. For the procurement of Non-expendable Supplies and Services: The Bidder must have completed a single contract that is similar to this Project, equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC.</p> <p>b. For the procurement of Expendable Supplies: The Bidder must have completed a single contract that is similar to this Project, equivalent to at least twenty-five percent (25%) of the ABC.</p> <p>c. For procurement where the Procuring Entity has determined, after the conduct of market research, that imposition of either (a) or (b) will likely result to failure of bidding or monopoly that will defeat the purpose of public bidding: the Bidder should comply with the following requirements: [Select either failure or monopoly of bidding based on market research conducted]</p> <p>i. Completed at least two (2) similar contracts, the aggregate amount of which should be equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) in the case of non-expendable supplies and services or twenty-five percent (25%) in the case of expendable supplies] of the ABC for this Project;</p> <p>ii. The largest of these similar contracts must be equivalent to at least half of the percentage of the ABC as required above.</p>	<p>Considering that this is the second time that the MIRDC is procuring a military-grade camera and that there was more than one bidder in that (previous) bidding, the Center will not be invoking this provision that would permit the aggregation of the amounts of completed similar contracts equivalent to at least 50% of the ABC for this project.</p>

2.	Bid Document Item 5.3, Item c.ii page 13 - our largest CCTV surveillance contract completed to date is PHP 921k, which is less than half the percentage of the ABC, will you consider MJZ in this case?	We will comply with 5.3 (a) of the Bid Documents which states that "[T]he bidder must have completed a single contract similar to this Project, equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC. "
3.	Bid Data Sheet: Item 5.3 - please consider CCTV surveillance system as similar project	If the CCTV surveillance system offered matches the technical specifications of the Military Camera System to be procured, then it can be considered.
4.	Technical Specifications: Item 3.03 - confirm training will be in-country at MIRDC facilities; and confirm number of participants	Training will be at MIRDC office in Bicutan, Taguig and there will be 10 participants.
5.	Technical Specifications: Item 3.08 - what does "3 days buy-off period excluding travel time before delivery" mean?	Buy-off period is also pre-delivery inspection period.
6.	Technical Specifications: Item 3.10 - what does "technology transfer on the application" comprise?	Technology transfer means support of the winning bidder up to the integration of the supplied Military Camera System for the technology being developed by MIRDC.
7.	Technical Specifications: Item 3.12 - Ingress Protection rating - unless MIRDC intends to install the system underwater, IP68 may be required. Otherwise, please relax this to IP67.	IP68 is the minimum requirement.
